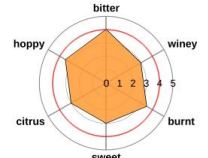




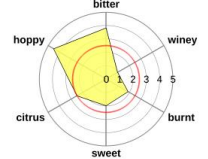

Bright golden colour with the zingy aroma of New World hops, the flavour is a citrusy punch with a lasting bitterness.



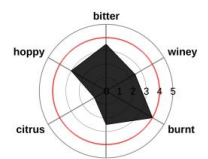

A traditional pale ale initially malty and delicately bittered with a long dry biscuit finish and citrus aromas.



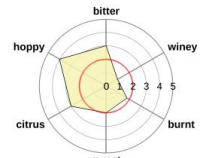
