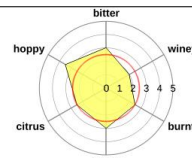




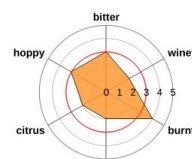

Brewed with First Gold English leaf hops.



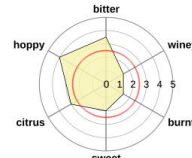

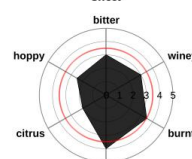

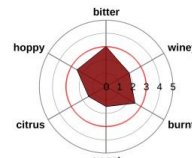

Dark-ruby-coloured, strong mild ale. Subtle roast and malt flavours with a mellow, sweetish finish.



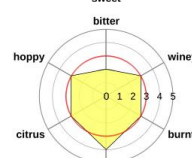
